How do I renew?

If you wish to maintain your traffic controller photocard in NSW you will need to apply through an RMS Approved Training Provider and undergo the renewal process by providing suitable evidence of currency as outlined below.

You will also be required to:

- Provide evidence of your identity and current address
- Pay an application/renewal fee

Option 1: Renewal No Training: \$150

To be eligible you must-

- Produce your RMS Photocard/s issued after the 1 July 2015
- Cards must still be current or recently expired (within 3 months)
- Provide details of 6 Traffic Control jobs you have worked on in the last 12 months
- Provide an employer declaration
 - If you are not able to meet these requirements, then select option 2 below

Option 2: 1 Day Refresher Training \$220

To be eligible you must-

- Produce your RMS Photocard/s issued after the 1 July 2015
- Cards must be still current or recently expired (within 3 months)
- Attend 1-day refresher training (includes theory questionnaire and practical)

Do you need to renew your RMS Photo Cards?

A person who is eligible to renew their NSW Photocards must undertake a renewal process. Photocards issued after the 1 of July 2015 have a 3-year expiry date. If the applicant fails to renew their photocard within 3 months after the photocard has expired, then the applicant will be required to complete the entire course again
