

Social Distancing and COVID-19 Controls for Traffic Control and Line Marking

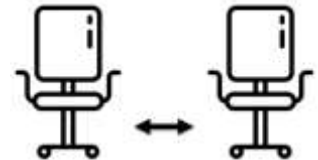


Rostering

- Try to keep the same crews working together to avoid mixing crews
- Where possible avoid crews travelling together in the same vehicle
- Look at options for people travelling straight to site
- Consider alternatives for sending and receiving paper work such as email or photos

At the depot


- Limit the amount of workers coming to the depot – essential workers only
- Stop all physical contact including shaking hands
- Regularly wash hands and use hand sanitisers
- Promote good hand, sneeze and cough hygiene
- Ensure good ventilation in work areas and/or open windows or doors
- Regularly clean and disinfect surfaces commonly touched by workers
- Eat lunch at desk or outside rather than in a lunchroom.
- Modify seating arrangements to maintain 1.5m gap between personnel

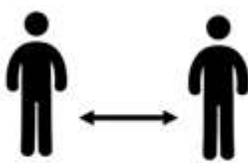


In vehicles

- Limit the number of people to 2 or less per vehicle where possible
- Wear work gloves when inside the vehicle
- Where available wear face mask inside vehicle when more than 1 person
- Regularly clean and disinfect hard surfaces – keep vehicle clean and tidy
- Leave windows open for ventilation
- Put the air con system on fresh – 
- Do not eat or drink in vehicles

With plant, equipment and PPE

- Use gloves when using or handling plant and equipment
- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer after using any plant or equipment
- Do not share PPE like gloves, hard hats, hats, safety glasses, face shields, masks
- Dispose of face masks in a bin – do not leave them laying around on the site or in vehicles
- Regularly clean PPE that can be cleaned – glasses, shirts, pants, hats



1.5m

At the worksite

- Maintain 1.5m distance between workers
- Avoid non-essential site visits. Consider holding meetings via video conferencing or phone calls
- Stop shaking hands to greet clients and workers
- Put off large group meetings – Including group inductions; toolbox meetings etc.
- If essential meetings are to be held, encourage the use of an outside environment and maintain 1.5m gap between workers
- Use your own pen to sign documents

Topic points to discuss with clients

- What are they doing regarding social distancing at work?
- What controls does the client have in place for controlling the spread of COVID-19?
- Stagger breaks – Limit the amount of personnel in lunchrooms
- Maintaining 1.5m distance between workers
- Remove non-essential personnel



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
